Welcome In and Welcome Back!

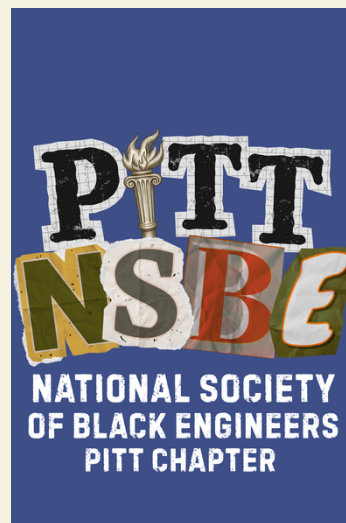

Welcome Back BBQ

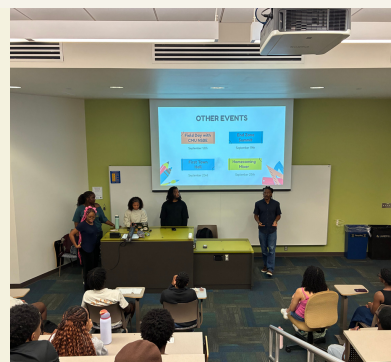
AUGUST 22
